Vinkara

The *Winebow Group* launched a line of Turkish wines this spring. The Vinkara range includes two white wines—the unoaked 2012 Narince (\$15 a 750-ml. bottle) and the 2011 Narince Reserve (\$25), which is aged for 14 months in French oak—as well as two red wines made from a grape similar to Pinot Noir—the unoaked Kalecik Karasi (\$15)

Puklavec & Friends

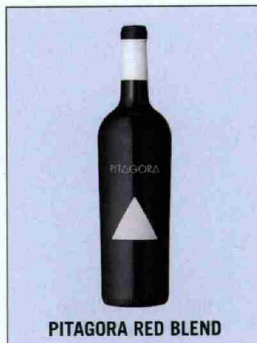

Underwood Rosé

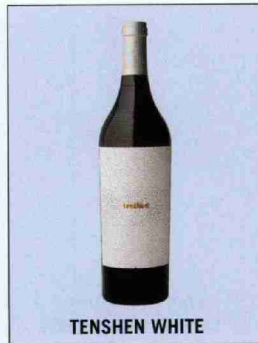

Venus Reigns (pricing varies by market) is made from fresh-pressed pear cider that was aged in red wine casks for 26 months and finished with natural honey. The 6.9-percent abv cider has notes of berries, pear and citrus. The cider is available in 22-ounce bottles



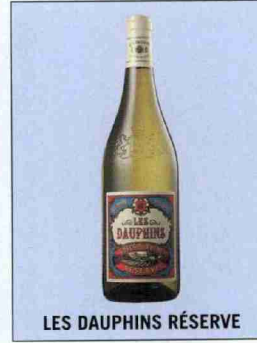
